Primary Care Ultrasound Application Form

The Program

The increasing availability and use of bedside ultrasound in primary care has created a demand for accessible, accredited, hands-on training.

RDWA in partnership with LearnEM, an accredited provider of Ultrasound training, has developed two-day intensive workshop that is equivalent to the ASUM accredited 3 to 5-day ultrasound programs offered interstate.

The training will provide participants with the range of bedside ultrasound diagnostic skills and ultrasound guided procedures required for the management of acutely ill or injured patient in rural emergency practice. These include use of ultrasound for the assessment of abdominal aortic aneurysm, ultrasound of the abdomen, heart and lung in the patient with severe trauma, use of ultrasound in fluid resuscitation of the patient with shock and use of ultrasound for emergency procedures including vascular access, placement of an arterial line and confirmation of intubation.

Delivered by Learn EM, the program is accredited with Royal Australian College of General Practitioners (RACGP), Australian College of Rural and Remote Medicine (ACRRM) and the Australasian Society for Ultrasound Medicine (ASUM).

The Primary Care Ultrasound workshop is accredited for 80 Cat 1 RACGP points for both the online and practical workshops and 30 PRPD + 30 points MOPS with ACCRM. The workshop meets the criteria for the Rural Procedural Grant for Emergency Medicine, Anaesthesia, Surgery and Obstetrics.

Participants will be assessed and issued certificate of completion where all elements have been successfully completed. RDWA funds the full cost of each place where all elements are completed by the participant. Should a participant not complete the pre workshop activities or not attend the full period of the workshop, the GP will be responsible for payment of the cost of that place - \$2,000.

Cancellations can be accepted until seven days before the workshop date. In applying you will be acknowledging that RDWA and LearnEM collect, retain and exchange relevant personal information in delivering this course to you.

Eligibility criteria

You can apply for a position on a Primary Care Ultrasound course if you:

- are a GP who lives in a rural town in SA;
- and practise as a GP in a SA rural location
